There are two ways to register for the SAT and SAT Subject Tests.

1) ONLINE REGISTRATION

The simplest way to register is online.
 You will need a credit card (American Express, MasterCard, Visa or Discover) to register online at: www.collegeboard.org.
 Once you register, you will receive immediate confirmation, a registration number and a test center assignment. The online registration deadlines are in the table above.

2) MAIL REGISTRATION THROUGH ETS EUROPE (INTERNATIONAL SAT REPRESENTATIVE)

International representatives (a.k.a. international service providers) are agents that provide a number of services for test registrants in their home countries. Some of these services include SAT registration, test center recruitment and management, in-language customer service and fee collection.

To register through a SAT representative, complete the paper registration form and enclose it in the international return envelope provided with the SAT Paper Registration Guide. Submit your paper registration with full payment by the mail registration deadline listed in the table above.

ADMISSION TICKET

Once you have registered for the SAT or SAT Subject Tests, you will be issued an admission ticket. If you registered on-line, you should print it out from your SAT on-line file. If you registered by mail, you will receive by mail, but it is also available online.

If you do not receive an admission ticket or cannot receive computer confirmation a few days before the test, call the EducationUSA office to check whether you have been registered at 22-669757.

WAITLIST TESTING

Students are required to pre-register for the SAT and SAT Subject Tests. Standby (walk-in) testing is no longer permitted. Students who have missed the regular registration deadline may be able to go online to request a waitlist status after the last registration deadline up until five days before test day. This service, known as “Waitlist” is only available online. Because this service is only available online, students will not be able to register late without a credit card. No fees will be charged unless a student is admitted to a test center.

- Students must report to the test center indicated on their Waitlist Ticket. Students who report to a different test center than the one on their admission ticket will not be admitted.
- As space and materials permit, students will be seated in the order in which they arrive. Students are not guaranteed a seat.
- As this service is entirely online, students must be able to retrieve the Waitlist Ticket online and print it out. Waitlist Tickets cannot be sent via postal mail.

Photographs

Whether registering online or by mail, all students will be required to submit a current, recognizable photo during registration that will be included on the new Admission Ticket. A passport-style or wallet-sized photo (approximately 2.5 by 3 inches) showing the head and shoulders is best. Students can see samples of acceptable and unacceptable photos and learn more about the requirements at: <http://sat.collegeboard.org/register/photo-requirements>.

The photo uploaded at registration must match the student’s appearance as he or she will appear on test day as well as the photo on ID presented at check-in. If a student’s appearance has changed substantially between two test administrations the student should upload (or mail) a current photo with the new test registration. If the photo on the admission ticket does not reasonably match the appearance of the individual attempting to enter the test center as well as the photo on his or her identification, the test taker will be turned away.

Identification

Students must present a photo identification on test day. Government-issued IDs, such as a passport or driver’s license are preferred, but secondary school photo ID cards are also acceptable, as is the SAT Student ID form, when appropriately notarized. Certain countries have different ID requirements. Students should always consult <http://sat.collegeboard.org/register/id-requirements> for up-to-date, detailed information about acceptable ID’s and other identification requirements.

Making Changes to Registration

Students who want to take the SAT at a different test center than the one designated during registration will be required to request such a change no later than two weeks prior to test day. Test center changes will no longer be permitted on test day. Students who want to change the type of test they intend to take (i.e., SAT rather than SAT Subject Tests) must do so no later than two weeks prior to test day. Test-type changes will no longer be permitted on test day.

Students will be required to present their Admission Ticket for admittance to their designated test center.

- Students who registered online will be able to print out their Admission Ticket by logging onto their online College Board account.
- Students who registered by mail can choose to have the Admission Ticket mailed or emailed prior to test day.
