HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE PAPER-BASED GRE GENERAL TEST

There are two ways to register for the GRE General Test. The quickest way is through the online registration.

- (1) **Online Registration:** If you have a credit/debit card (Mastercard, Visa, American Express, Discover, JCB) you can register online.

Go to the GRE website at www.ets.org/gre and click on "Register for the Test".

Late Registration (for on-line registration only): Late registration closes one week after regular registration deadline. The cost of late registration is an additional \$25.

- (2) **Mail Registration:** To register by mail, you may download the *2014-15 Registration Form for the Paper-based GRE revised General Test* (PDF) from the GRE website www.ets.org/gre. Complete the form and mail it with the payment (\$195) to:

Fees may be paid by credit/debit card (Mastercard, Visa, American Express, Discover, JCB), bank draft, money order or check (in U.S. dollars) made payable to ETS-GRE.

Registration Forms must be received by ETS in the U.S. by the mail registration deadlines. Registration forms cannot be faxed.

Please allow up to 4 weeks for processing.

Free Test Preparation Material

Since the GRE revised General Test, which was introduced in August 2011, features a new design and new question types, using test prep for the prior version of the GRE General Test is not recommended. The good news is FREE official test prep materials are available on the GRE website. Go to www.ets.org/gre and click on "Prepare for the Test" on the left-hand side.

In addition to the sample questions, strategies and tips available here on this site, this free software also includes two full-length practice tests. These timed tests simulate the test taking experience, including the test-taker friendly design features like moving back and forth and changing answers within a section, as well as the on-screen calculator.

Standby Testing

Standby testing may be available, if other individuals have registered for the test, and if sufficient space, test materials, and staff are available at the test center.

On the day of the examination, report to Turk Maarif College by 8:15 am with the following:

- Completed registration form.
- Test fee payment (standby fee is \$50, in addition to the \$195). Fees may be paid by credit/debit card (Mastercard, Visa, American Express, Discover, JCB), bank draft, money order or check (in U.S. dollars) made payable to ETS-GRE. Cash will not be accepted.
- Acceptable and valid photo identification (see details below).

Admission to the test is not guaranteed for standby test takers. Standby registrants will be admitted on a first-come, first-served basis.

Identification Requirements

Before being admitted to the test, all test-takers will need to present valid identification. The name on your registration must match the name on your identification document. It must be current and contain a recent, recognizable photo and signature.

Acceptable forms of identification include the following:

- Valid passport.
- Valid driver's license (with photograph and signature).
- Cypriot ID, only if it is accompanied by another form of ID that bears a photograph and signature.
